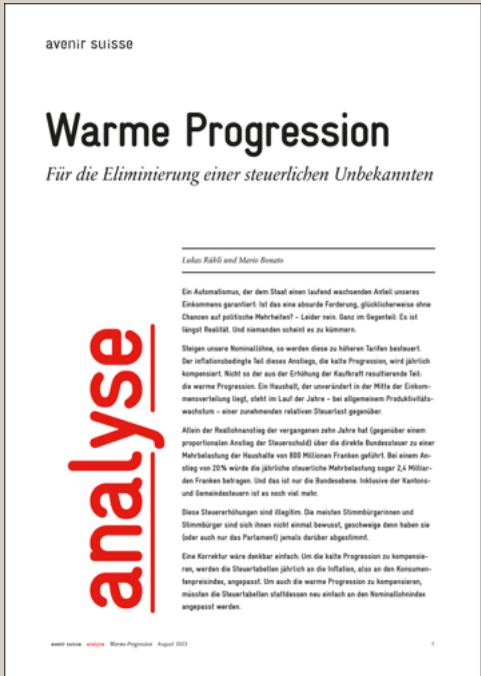

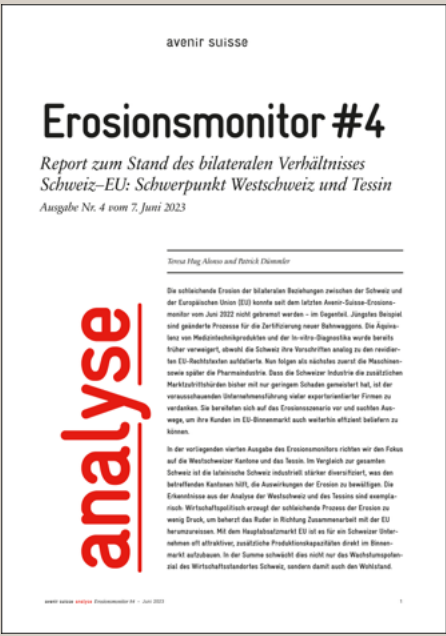
Why Are Banks Regulated in the First Place?
